### Additional Conditions:

1. The health care facility shall treat the sewage in STP arrangements.
2. The health care facility shall comply with the provisions of Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016 without any deviations.
3. The health care facility shall ensure segregation of liquid chemical waste at source and ensure pre-treatment or neutralization prior to mixing with other effluent generated from their premises.
4. The health care facility shall disinfect the trade effluent using at least 1 to 2% sodium hypochlorite solution or any other chemical reagent that should demonstrate 4 Log 10 reduction efficiency for microorganisms.
5. The health care facility shall ensure that the Bio Medical wastes are segregated as per the color coding prescribed and shall ensure that all the BMW shall be disposed to the CBMWT facilitator without any accumulation.
6. The health care facility shall maintain records of collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment and disposal and or any form of handling bio medical waste in accordance with the rules and records shall be subject to inspection and verification by the Board at any time.
7. The health care facility shall ensure that biomedical waste shall not be mixed with any other wastes.
8. The health care facility shall make fresh application for change of management if any.
9. The health care facility's activity shall not attract any public complaint.
10. In case of revision of consent fee by the Government, the health care facility shall remit the difference in amount within one month from the date of notification.
